The Bahari 525 is the first of the Bahari range — a fast cruising blue water catamaran that brings together performance, comfort, and elegance. She is not a stripped-out racer, nor a heavy, slow cruiser, but a yacht created for sailors who want the best of both worlds: the exhilaration of speed with the reassurance of luxury.

Every detail has been shaped by designers and builders who have logged thousands of sea miles themselves. The result is a yacht that feels instinctive to sail and effortless to live aboard.

Interiors are laid out with a sailor's understanding of flow and ergonomics, ensuring natural movement between saloon, cockpit, galley, and helm. Semi-custom layouts allow each owner to choose

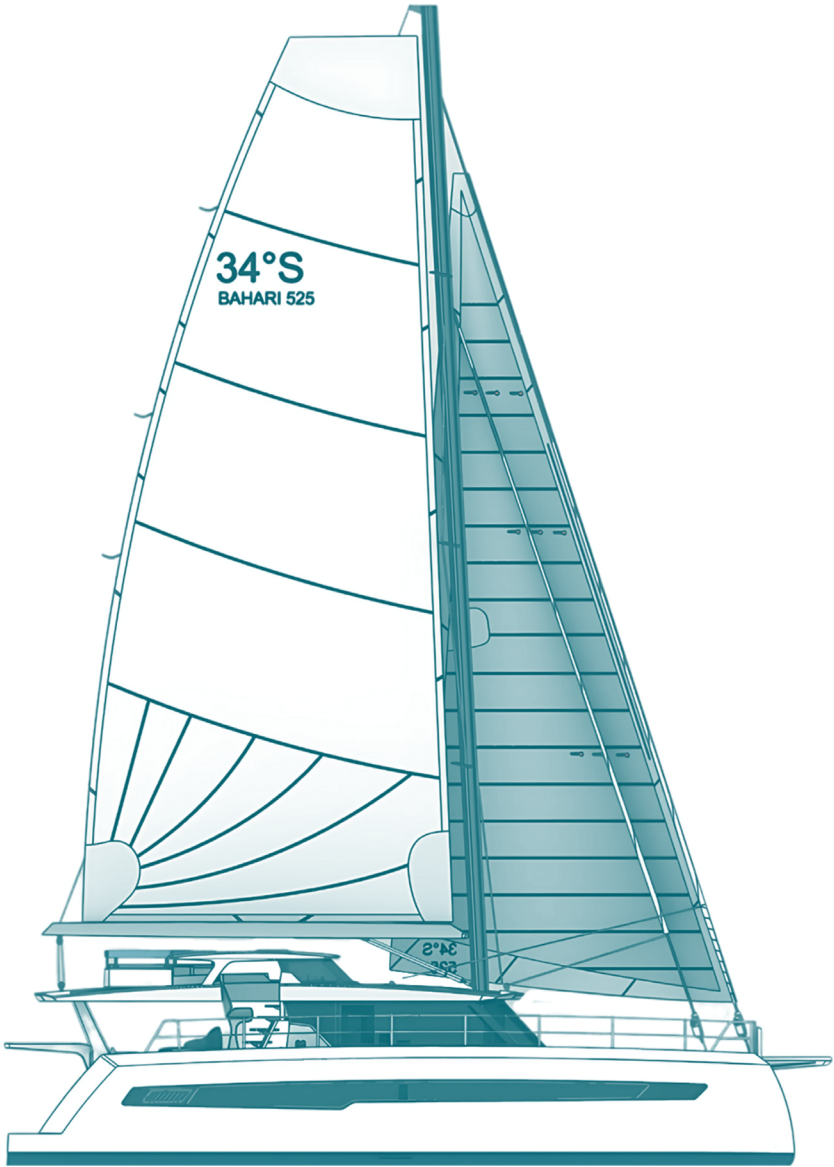
between a three-cabin or four-cabin configuration, while the option of a flybridge or no-flybridge version ensures the yacht reflects your own sailing style — whether sportier or more leisure-oriented.

Forward, the trampoline area transforms into a refined living space, complete with custom full-size mattresses and a dedicated awning for shade or stargazing. Throughout, finishes are precision-crafted and materials are carefully chosen, bringing together durability and beauty in every line.

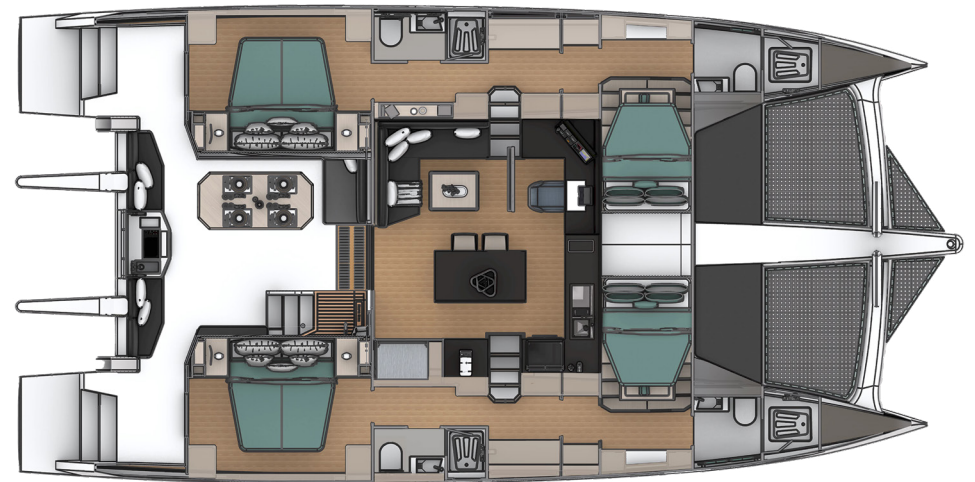
Semi-custom to your lifestyle

3-Cabin Layout

Three-cabin: a lavish owner's hull with a transverse berth aft, full ensuite, and flexible forward space. The guest hull offers two spacious ensuite cabins.



4-Cabin Layout

Four-cabin: mirrored hulls, each with fore and aft cabins, transverse queen-size berths, and private ensuites.

Bahari owners can configure the 525 to suit their sailing style.

- With flybridge: An elevated lounge and helm station create an extra outdoor space seating 8–10 guests, perfect for entertaining.
- Without flybridge: A sleeker profile and sportier sailing feel, ideal for those who prioritise pure sailing performance. Every Bahari is unique to its owner.

Forward on the bow, the trampoline transforms into a full forward living area. A set of custom, full-size mattresses turns the space into a sun-drenched or shaded lounge, thanks to a specially designed awning. It's the perfect spot to gaze at the horizon, day or night.



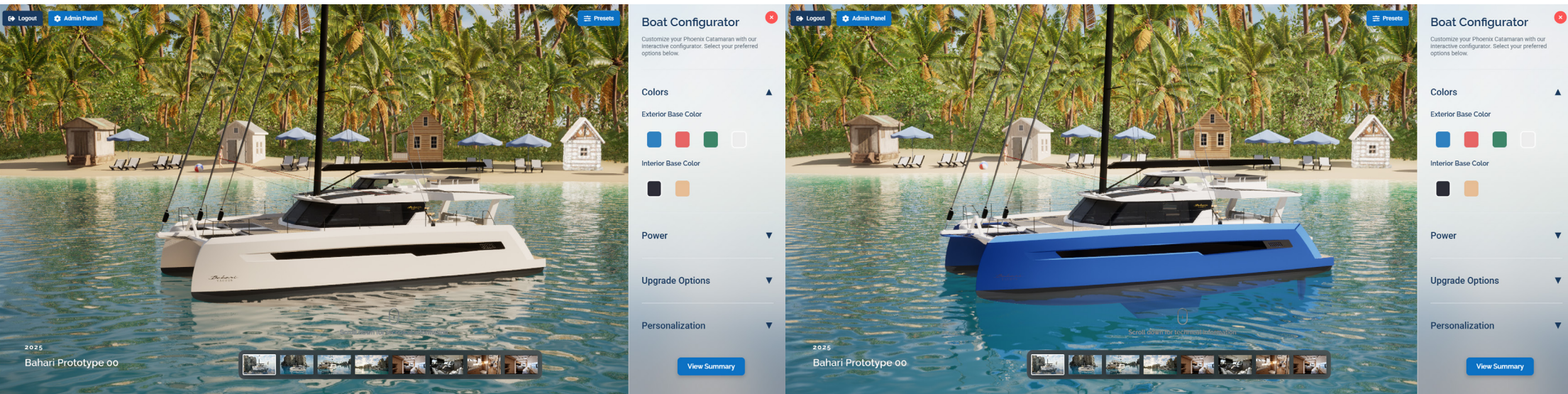
Ergonomics at heart

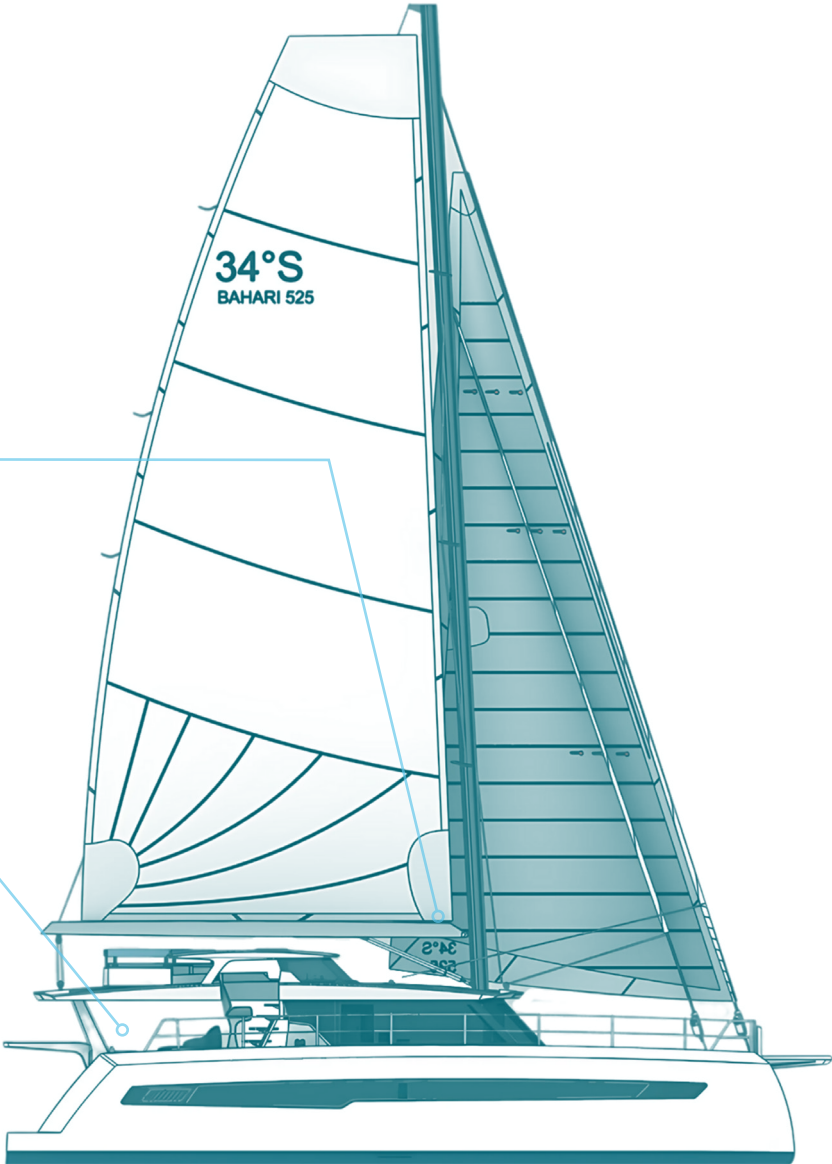

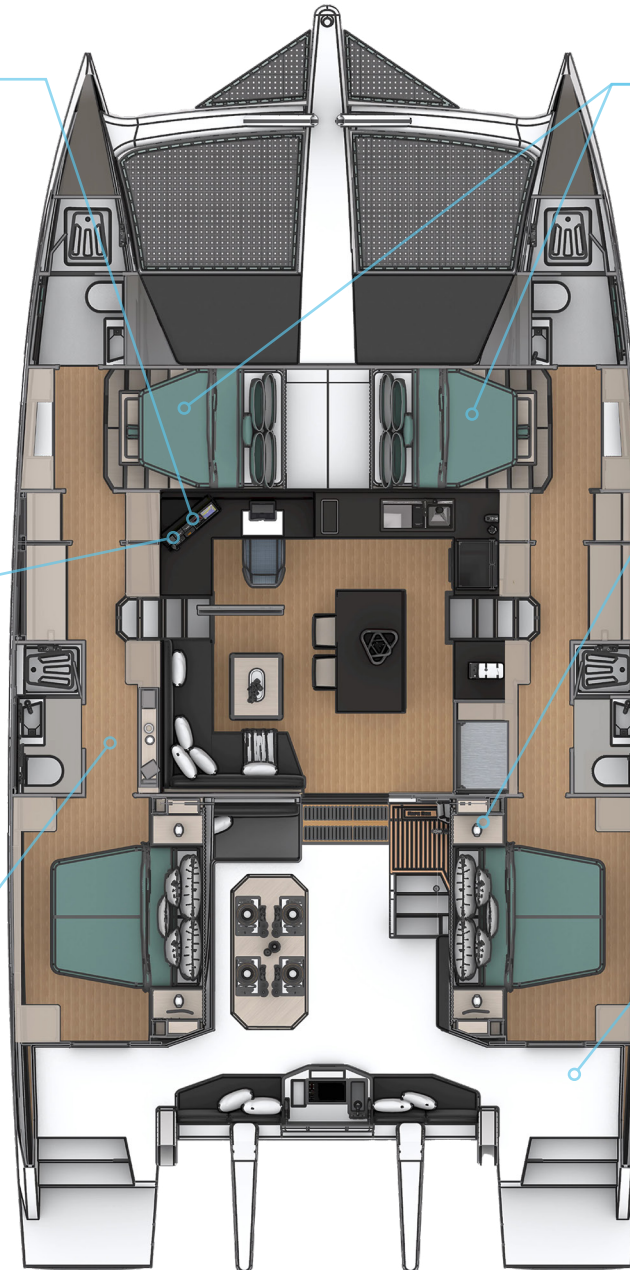
